Development of FM Ridesource

The FM Ridesource Directory provides the metropolitan area of Fargo and West Fargo, North Dakota and Moorhead and Dilworth, Minnesota with a list of transportation services primarily for people with disabilities and people over age 60. All of the transportation services, including private transportation providers and government supported transit, are available to the public. This information is also available at www.fmridesource.com.

The FM metropolitan area is a regional medical center and a hub of human and social services. The population needing access to these services is growing and transportation is an important part of living independently. This directory is designed to make it easier for you to see all of the specialized transportation options in one place. This year we are pleased to partner with FirstLink to add 2-1-1 as a resource for people seeking a list of transportation options - as well as information on other community services - 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

FM Ridesource was first printed in 2010 in place of the *Directory of Transportation Services* published annually by Fargo - Moorhead Metropolitan Council of Governments (Metro COG) since 1978. This is a joint mobility management project of Fargo-Moorhead Metro Area Transit (MATBUS) and Metro COG. MATBUS is jointly operated by the Cities of Fargo and Moorhead. This Directory will be updated annually. The information may change between printings. It is best to contact the transportation provider for the most up to date information.



All you have to do is press 2-1-1 on your telephone and you will discover contact information for specialized transportation, health and human service providers in the

area. 2-1-1 callers in North Dakota and Clay County, Minnesota will be connected to FirstLink Helpline, which provides confidential listening and support in addition to information and referral. You can call 2-1-1 anytime 24 hours a day/7 days a week. You can explore the FirstLink database by clicking the *Community Resources* button at **www.myfirstlink.org**.

You will receive **contact information only** when calling 2-1-1. You will be responsible for calling the transportation provider if you want to arrange a ride to your destination.

Type of Service: Individual service directly from origin to destination.

Hours of Service:

- 8:00am to 9:00pm, Monday through Friday.
- 8:00am to 7:00pm on Saturday.
- 24 hour stretcher service.
- 24 hour wheelchair service for prescheduled rides if scheduled before 5:00pm on Friday.

Scheduling Requirements: Advanced scheduling is preferred to guarantee times and availability of drivers for wheelchair users, but not required during the hours of 8:00am and 9:00pm, Monday through Friday and 8:00am and 7:00pm on Saturday.

Eligibility Requirements: None

- Metro Area – One way \$18 plus \$1.40 per mile.
- Round trip \$40 at time of service.
- Hospital Discharge (one way) - \$30 in Metro area.

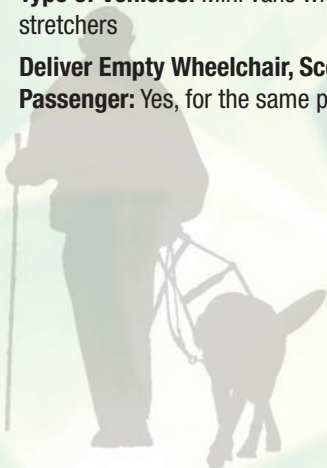

Purpose of Service: Non-emergency wheelchair transportation and ND Medicaid transportation.

Type of Service: Shared ride service which means the driver may pick up and drop off other passengers on the way to the rider's destination.

Hours of Service: 6:00am to 6:00pm Monday through Friday. Weekend rides based on attendance.

Scheduling Requirements: Reservations are required by noon the day before the scheduled ride. Rides scheduled for Monday must be called in by noon on Friday.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Regular Ride or Medical Ride: For people who have a physical, cognitive or emotional disability.
- Medicaid Ride to Access Medical Care: Rider must be Medicaid eligible. Rides are provided free-of-charge to the passenger and Medicaid is billed on their behalf. If there is client recipient liability, the passenger will be billed \$13 per trip.

Purpose of Service: Buses that travel on predetermined or fixed routes on regular schedules in Fargo, West Fargo, and Moorhead.

Type of Service: Ramp equipped buses.

Hours of Service: 6:15am to 10:15pm, Monday through Friday. 7:15am to 10:15 on Saturday.

Scheduling Requirements: Printed bus schedules identify when the buses will be on specific routes.

Eligibility Requirements: Discount fare for people with disabilities, people age 60 and older, and Medicare card holders. Show the driver a Medicare card (red, white and blue card) or MAT special user card for a discounted fare. Applications for a special user card are available at the MATBUS Ground Transportation Center (GTC). 502 NP Avenue, Fargo, ND 58102 – 701-232-7500.

Cost of ride:

- Adult single ride: \$1.25 (this might increase to \$1.50 in 2012)
- Adult 30-Day Pass: \$40
- Discount single ride: 60 cents (this might increase to 75 cents in 2012)
- Discount 30-Day Pass: \$26
- Youth single ride: 60 cents (this might increase to 75 cents in 2012)
- Child (birth to preschool): Free with adult
- Disabled veterans with “service connected” picture ID: Free on Moorhead MAT fixed route buses only
- NDSU, MSUM, MSCTC, and Concordia U-Pass: Free with current college ID

Type of Service: Shared ride service which means the driver may pick up and drop off other passengers on the way to the rider's destination.

Hours of Service: 6:15am to 10:15pm, Monday through Friday. 7:15am to 10:15pm on Saturday. 7:00am to 5:00pm on Sunday for Fargo and West Fargo residents.

Scheduling Requirements: Reservations must be made at least one day before the scheduled ride. Reservations are accepted up to 7 days prior to the scheduled ride.

Eligibility Requirements: A person who is functionally able to use the fixed route bus including getting to the bus stop, using the ramp equipped bus, and navigating the fixed route system might not be eligible for Paratransit. Applications are available at www.matbus.com and Metro Area Transit, 650 23rd St. N, Fargo, ND 58102. Eligibility can be permanent, temporary, or conditional and is determined within 3 weeks of receiving a complete application and verification from an approved professional.

Cost of ride: \$2.50 per ride. In 2012, the cost of a ride might increase to \$3.00.

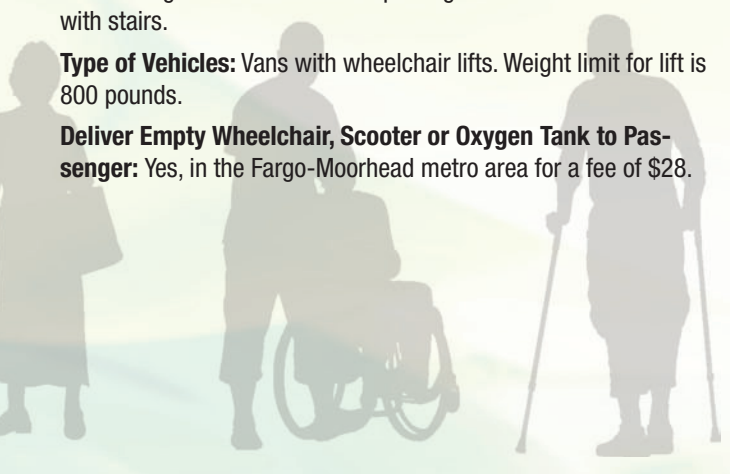

Bus drivers are not allowed to provide assistance of a personal nature to passengers.
