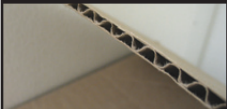

Unacceptable	Office paper, egg cartons, phone books and large catalogs with glue bindings such as Sears and JCPenny.
Preparation	Newspapers and magazines can be mixed together in one brown paper bag. Or lay them flat in the bottom of the bin without a bag.
Unacceptable	Scrap metal (car parts, iron & steel), razor blades, tin foil, nails, rusty cans, aerosol cans.
Preparation	Please rinse the cans. Labels do not have to be removed from tin cans. Please place the lid inside the can or bend the lid inside the can. Aluminum cans and steel or tin cans can be mixed together in one brown paper bag.
Unacceptable	Motor oil, vegetable oil or antifreeze bottles, yogurt or cottage cheese containers, margarine tubs, ice cream pails, plastic bags, toys and any container numbered #3 - #7.
Preparation	Please rinse all bottles and remove caps and lids. Place plastic bottles in a brown paper bag.
Unacceptable	Ceramics, Pyrex, window glass or light bulbs.
Preparation	Please rinse bottles and jars and remove lids and corks. Labels do not need to be removed. Place all glass together in a brown paper bag.
Unacceptable	Box board (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, pop cases), wax-coated cardboard, dirty pizza boxes.
Preparation	MUST BE FLATTENED and placed underneath your curbside bin.
